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




## Nearly 49 million Americans live where dentists are scarce

#### Children ages 0-21



#### Adults ages 20-64



### Medicaid matters for communities of color

 In 2011, nearly 1/3 of non-elderly African Americans relied on Medicaid or other public insurance, compared with 15% of white people

 More than half of all African American children relied on Medicaid, compared with 26% of white children

## **Expensive and Inadequate Care**


- In 2012, two million Americans visited ERs for dental problems at a total cost of \$1.6 billion
- Medicare and Medicaid paid \$679 million




## **Expanding the dental team**

- Make community-based care models more economically sustainable






FQHC Revenues: People's Health Center Minneapolis, MN
